LEGAL ADULT USE

Retail: Alaska, California, Colorado, Nevada, Oregon, Washington
Retail coming: Maine, Massachusetts
No retail: Washington, DC



SMALL AMOUNTS DECRIMINALIZED

Connecticut, Delaware, Illinois, Maryland, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Rhode Island, Vermont

LEGAL MEDICAL USE

Arizona, Arkansas, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Hawaii, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Montana, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont, West Virginia



CBD-ONLY LAWS

Alabama, Georgia, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Wisconsin, Wyoming

NO DECRIM, MMJ, OR CBD
